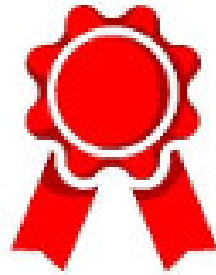

The children studied the remains of the houses and learnt how these, unlike many others in different parts of the country, were built in a courtyard formation and made from stone walls rather than wattle and daub.
