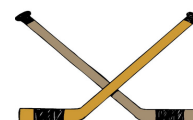
Wilfred Lloyd-King who (with a bit of help from Dad, Ben, at the helm) recently crewed in the South West Mirror Opens and came second!!

Take note of the fantastic result of the Year 5 boys' 600m race in the table below.



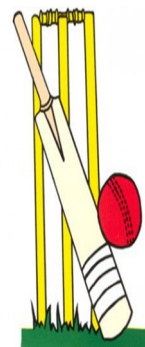

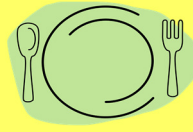
